 Learn downtown Brockton lore.

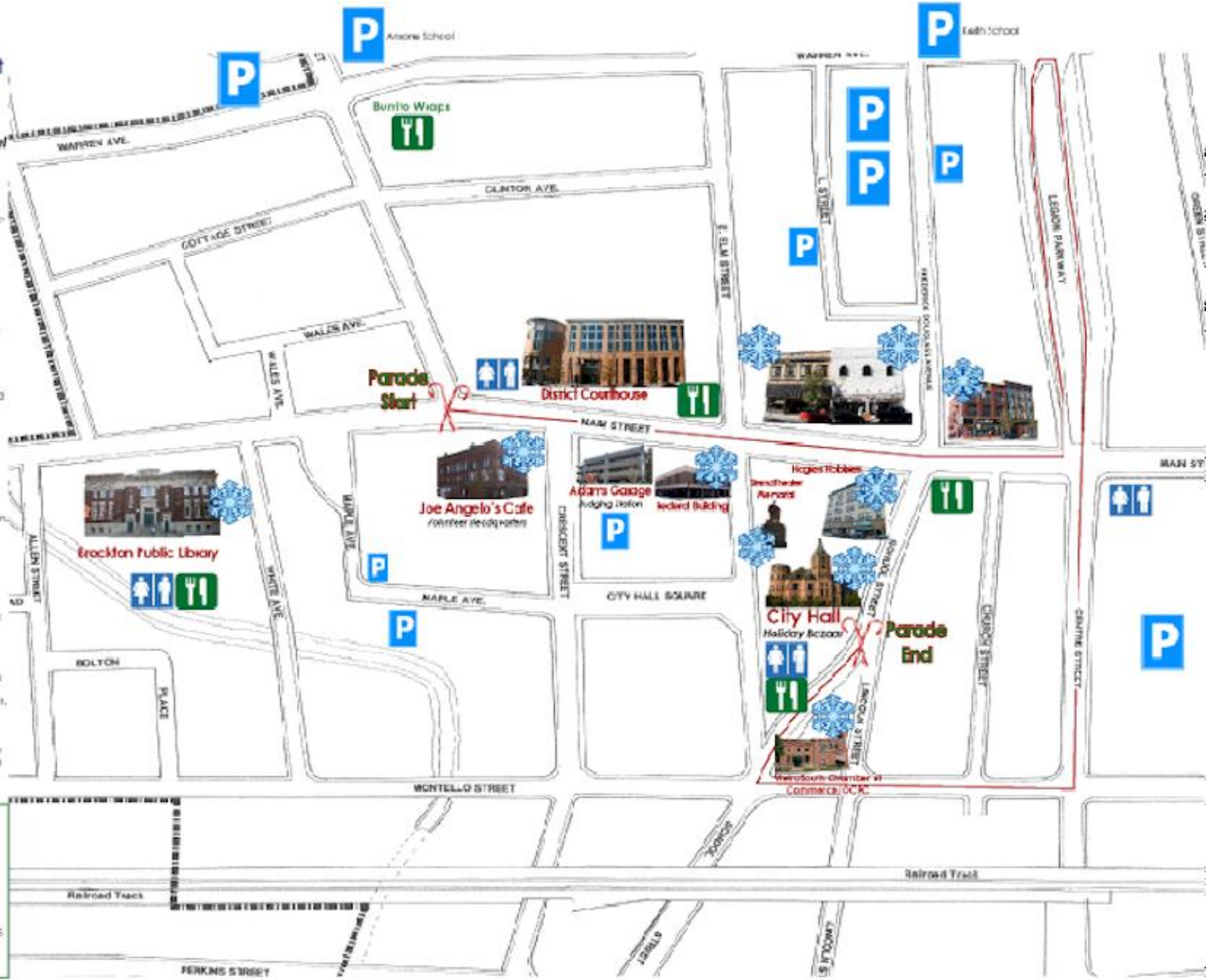
